

Christian Fellowship Academy & High School SCRIP Program Guidelines

Tuition Credit

Participating families will receive 60% of the percentages the vendors offer, and CFA/HS will receive 40% less expenses. The time frame is one year, from June 1 – May 31. Tuition credits are applied to the following school year.

Payment

Personal checks or cash for the full amount of the order are the only forms of payment accepted. Checks are to be made payable to “CFA SCRIP.” Place the family name to receive credit in the memo portion of the check.

Forms

Only one form is required for both “In-Stock” items (front of the order form) and “Special Order” items (back of the form). Order forms are available to download from the website at www.cfcfa.org, and the forms are also available in the foyer.

Sales

“In-Stock” SCRIP is sold during school on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 11:30 am – 12:00 pm. Families may also send in an order with their child in an interdepartmental mail envelope. The seller will fill the order and place it in the school office or send it home with your child, according to the option you select at the bottom of the form. The school is not responsible for filled orders that are given to your child. *Once purchased, SCRIP cards cannot be returned.* “Special Order” SCRIP forms are due at the school Monday by 10:00 am and will be available by Friday of the same week provided that it is not a holiday week.

Availability

SCRIP is based on availability; at times it may be necessary to place back orders.

Additional Exciting Information

Currently Lowes, Kohls, and JCPenney credit card bills may be paid at the store with gift cards purchased from the school SCRIP program. You can also use Giant Eagle and Shop-N-Save SCRIP cards to purchase other gift cards from the stores to receive fuel perks. This is a win-win situation!
